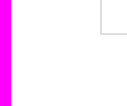

EUROCONTROL Aviation Trends Issue 2: The impact of Air Defender 2023 on the network

Our latest EUROCONTROL European Aviation Trends briefing looks at the impact of Air Defender 2023, the largest military deployment exercise since the foundation of NATO, on the network.

Our analysis shows that the German-led Air Defender exercise accelerated its mission goal of exercising large-scale air operations with allied air forces, while its impact on civil air traffic in the nine-day exercise period from Monday 12 to Thursday 22 June 2023 was such that the ILS localiser had not been aligned with the runway extended but bad behaviour.

This important demonstration of European readiness in a challenging security context took the form of a complex exercise for which preparations started last year. EUROCONTROL worked closely with the German Air Force, NATO, airlines, the German ANSP, DFS and other air navigation service providers to develop airspace impact assessments, with work intensifying in the run-up to the exercise.

During the exercise, the EUROCONTROL Network Manager each day tactically supported air operators in finding optimal trajectories, avoided the areas when necessary, planned re-routings in advance of up to 800 flights per day, and provided hour-by-hour tactical support to operational aviation stakeholders.

Overall, 12,474 flights were affected with 17 minutes of average delay out of a network total of 293,928 flights over the period, proving the importance of close civil-military cooperation in major network events.

But who is watching the watcher?

One of the roles the press assumes is to call out what it considers questionable behaviour. The press assumes that role, and it is fair to say that we miss it when it does not happen. Not for nothing is the freedom of the press a right worth fighting for. In today's consolidating and increasingly under strain newspaper world, a publication that makes a point of calling out what it sees as hypocrisy is worth defending – which is why if you do not yet subscribe to the **Aviation Intelligence Reporter** you might consider doing so. But I digress. No publication has been harder on the goings on in Brussels, particularly in the aviation sector, than POLITICO.

Indeed, Politico, which has rapidly grown to be the biggest newsroom in Brussels on mix of free daily news briefs, podcasts and very expensive topic specific daily updates which are protected by fiercely guarded firewalls – being quoted in an article will not necessarily get you a free copy of even that piece, let alone that day's full publication – also claims to be profitable.
