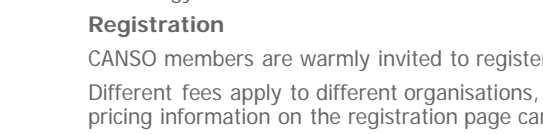

### Notice of Strike by ASECNA Air Traffic Controllers - A Dialogue of the Deaf that Undermines Air Safety



#### PRESS RELEASE - ISSUED ON MONDAY 25 JULY 2022

The Association of Air Traffic Controllers' Trade Unions of the Agency for the Safety of Air Navigation in Africa and Madagascar (USYCAA) hereby informs the public opinion that it has filed a notice of strike, which will take effect from Thursday 25 August 2022 at 8 a.m. GMT until Saturday 27 August 2022 at 7:59 a.m. GMT, and then for an indefinite period until all its demands are met.

This call for a strike is triggered by the abusive, arrogant and threatening approach of the general management, which refuses any dialogue with the USYCAA. Actually, the Association - legally constituted and registered in Abidjan, Ivory Coast, and with close to 700 members - has so far voiced some demands, which have never come to fruition.

- Technology Dilemma

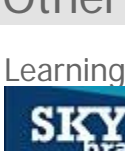
All in all, we will have three days of great face-to-face conversations and debate, along with enjoying the much appreciated hospitality of our host AAI.

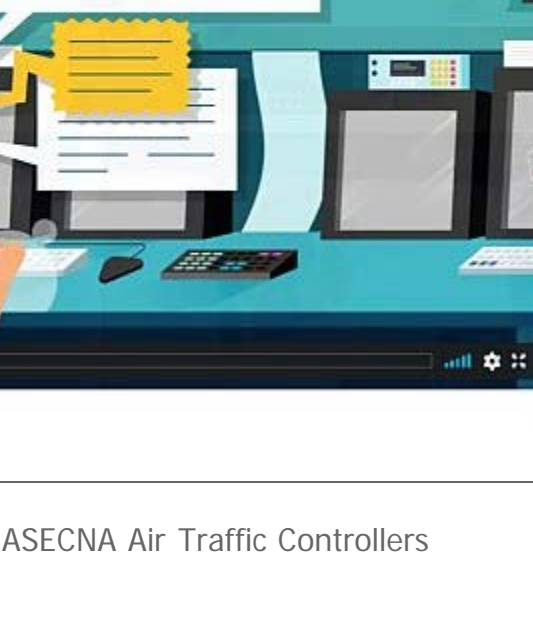

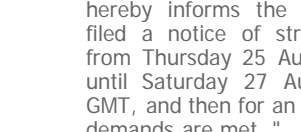
- At EUROCONTROL level, traffic in the first seven months of 2022 increased by 85% compared to the same period in 2021 but remained 19.6% below the level in 2019.

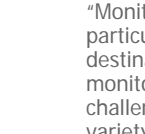

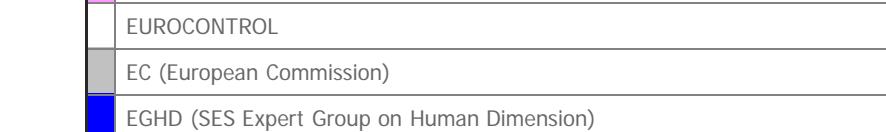

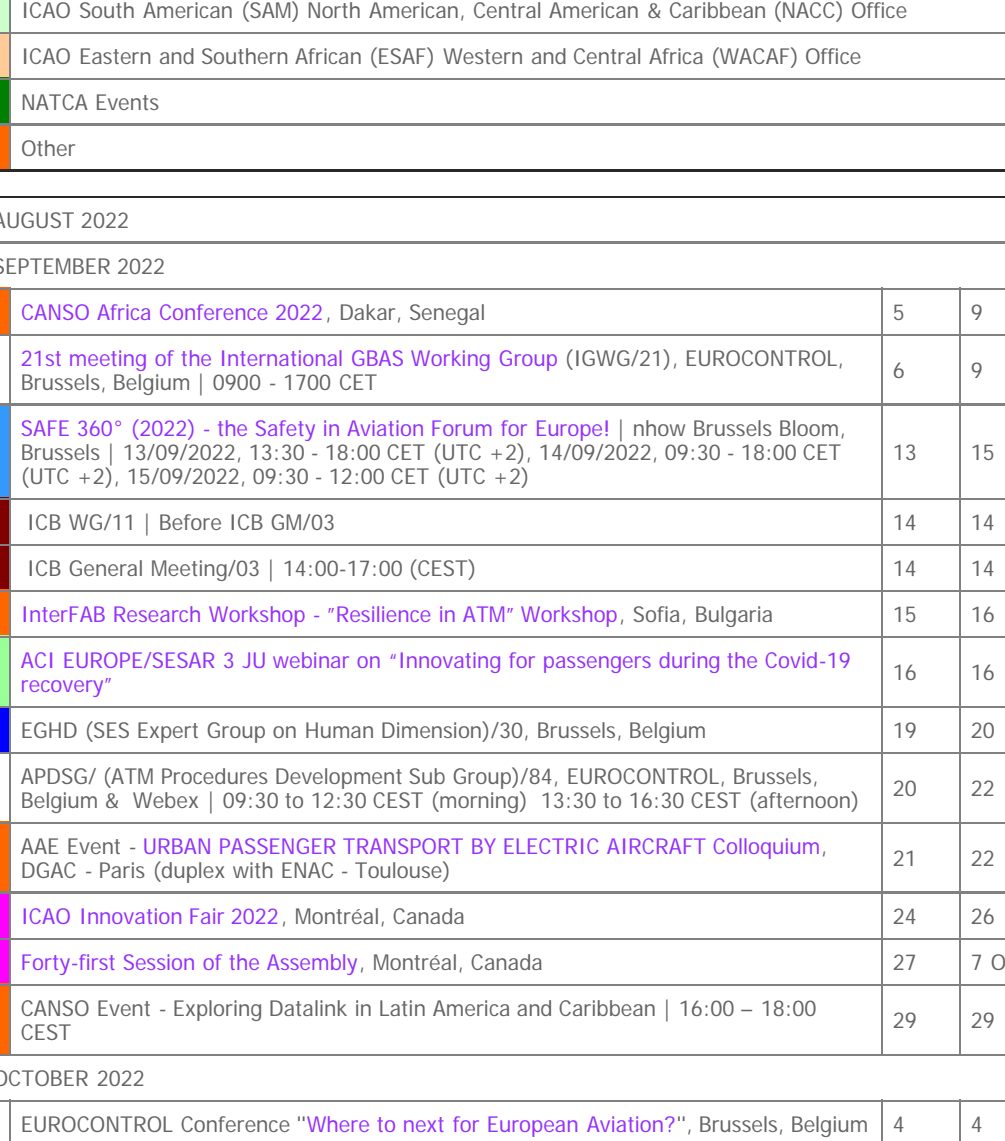

### Learning Matters. Your SKYlight of August 2022



Welcome to the August 2022 edition of SKYlight - "Safety Intelligence as a Service". This month we take a look at cross-checking for air traffic controllers. We also have several new articles prepared by members of our editorial team.

#### Cross-checking and the Controller



#### Cross-checking the actions of pilots

Where possible, the controller should monitor the actions of the pilot, either by reference to the radar screen or by visual observation. The controller should ensure that instructions are followed correctly. Controllers should pay particular attention to aircraft manoeuvring on the ground near runway hotspots.

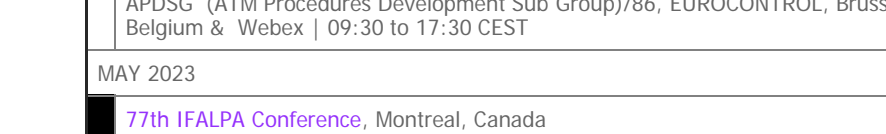
#### Cross-checking the actions of colleagues

Cross-checking is a normal part of the duties of an ATC Assistant if these exist; otherwise, controllers rarely have the free capacity to monitor the duties of other controllers and such action could not be expected to form part of their duties. Nevertheless, the following areas are important:

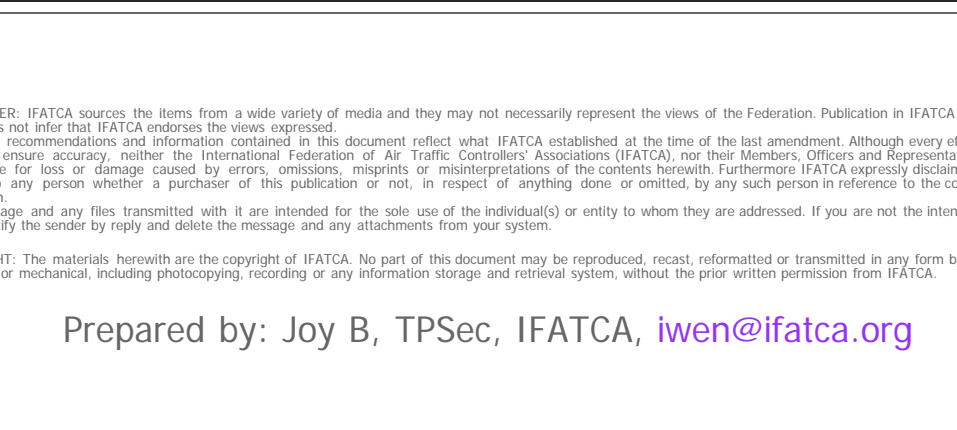
- When there are two controllers assigned to a sector, the communication with aircraft is normally done by the senior controller. The planner controller however also monitors the radio exchanges (to the extent possible) so that they can detect lapses, incorrect readbacks, etc.
- Controllers taking over responsibility for a sector have much information to absorb and the potential for error or oversight is high. The controller going off duty should monitor the actions of their replacement for a few minutes after hand-over to ensure that neither has overlooked any significant aspect of the prevailing traffic situation and to be available to deal with any questions that might arise.
- When a controller is dealing with an abnormal, e.g. an aircraft emergency or very high density traffic, the enlistment of any off-duty controllers to assist can be an important safety net.

The International Air Transport Association (IATA) announced the launch of AVSEC Insight, an online platform offering users a comprehensive range of timely, open-source, information to aid in identifying potential security risks and threats to their operations and businesses.

"Monitoring risks is both difficult and time-consuming, particularly for airlines with international operations. Adding destinations means more intelligence collection and monitoring is required. AVSEC Insight responds to this challenge by gathering risk-related information from a wide variety of sources, including niche and local-language news media as well as NOTAMs (Notice to Air Missions) and other official sources. It enables users to manage and identify business risks at early stages, monitor them in real time, and conduct post event analysis. The tool covers threats and continuity risks from natural disasters, civil unrest and protests, geopolitical developments, transnational crime and cybersecurity to name a few," said Matthew Vaughan, IATA's Director Aviation Security and Cyber."
