Amendment to the AMC/GM to SERA (Radiotelephony Phraseologies for pilot-ATCO Voice Communications)



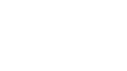
Issue 1, amendment 5 to the AMC/GM to the rules of the air (Amendments to the SERA radiotelephony phraseologies for pilot-air traffic controller voice communications).

This Decision issues amendments to the SERA radiotelephony (RT) phraseologies in order to ensure the necessary harmonisation in the voice communications between pilots and air traffic controllers, and to prevent any misunderstanding that would potentially result in safety issues, especially in a critical phase of the flight such as the approach.

The completion of this rulemaking task ensures the full and timely alignment of the SERA RT phraseologies with those applicable at global level, as recently amended by ICAO through Amendment 11 to Doc 4444 'PANS-ATM'.

On 29 February 2020, an aircraft inbound to Delhi lost separation against an outbound A320 from Delhi on a reciprocal track and the conflict was resolved by TCAS RA activation. The investigation found that the inbound aircraft had correctly read back its descent clearance but then set a different selected altitude. Air Traffic Control had not reacted to the unannounced conflict alert and was unable to resolve it when the corresponding warning followed, and it was noted that convective weather meant most aircraft were requesting deviations from their standard routes which was leading to abnormally complex workload.
